

## Michael Lee Hildenbrand Sr.


May 15, 1951 - September 5, 2016

Michael Lee Hildenbrand, Sr., 65, of Keomah Village, passed away Monday, September 5, 2016, at his home. He was born May 15, 1951, in Des Moines, Iowa, the son of Leonard and Darlene Hildenbrand.
