Nancy Engeman, 80, of Oskaloosa, died Sunday, July 22, 2018, at the MHP Hospice Serenity House in Oskaloosa. She was born September 19, 1937, in Sandwich, Illinois, the daughter of Stephen and Elna Walker Brimicombe. She graduated from Sandwich, Illinois High School with the class of 1955.
